The federal government must improve the income security of people with an intellectual disability by:



Implementing a targeted federal income program for working-age people with a disability.

Updating eligibility for federal programs for people with an intellectual or developmental disability.



Providing adequate low-cost internet access and affordable cell phone data plans to low-income people.



Loosening rules for RDSP withdrawals to allow people more access to their money.



Automatically granting the Disability Tax Credit to people who qualify for other disability benefits.



Separating the eligibility for the RDSP from the Disability Tax Credit.



Ensuring that GBA+ analysis includes a robust disability lens for all government programs, policies, initiatives, and data collection.



Eliminating barriers to applying for the Disability Tax Credit, including the costs.



Changing access to federal benefits so they don't depend on filing a tax return.



Increasing the Disability Supplement for the Canada Worker's Benefit.
